- Be prepared to receive Jesus in the Eucharist with reverence and joy.

- 1. Attendance: Please ensure your child attends each lesson and Sunday Mass regularly.
- 2. **Prayer at Home:** Encourage daily prayer and family participation in faith.
- 3. **Practice:** Help your child learn the prayers they need to know (Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be, Act of Contrition) and complete the pre/homework for each lesson.
- **4. Participation:** Support your child in activities, crafts, and service opportunities.

5. What Next:

- 1. To register your child for the First Holy Communion program, please complete the enclosed Registration form and return to the Parish Office no later than **September 14**, 2025.
- 2. When registering your child, please use their First and Last (Surname) only.
- 3. When returning the registration forms, include your child's baptism certificate.
- 4. The cost to cover the materials that will be used for the lessons is £25 per child. Grateful if payments could be made at the first parent meeting on 5 October and no later than 18 October.
